RESOLUTION EXPRESSING PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES AND CONFERRING A POSTHUMOUS AWARD OF RECOGNITION TO THE LATE ATTY. AMOR DOMINADO DELOSO, FORMER MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BOTOLAN AND FORMER GOVERNOR OF THE PROVINCE OF ZAMBALES, FOR HIS DISTINGUISHED PUBLIC SERVICE AND UNWAVERING DEDICATION TO THE PEOPLE OF ZAMBALES, WITH PRAYERS THAT THE LORD ALMIGHTY GRANT HIS SOUL ETERNAL REST

Whereas, the Almighty God, in His infinite wisdom and sovereign divine plan, has called upon the eternal home our esteemed former public servant, leader, and elder statesman, **ATTY. AMOR DOMINADO DELOSO**, on July 20, 2026 at the age of 87;

Whereas, affectionately known to his constituents and loved ones as “Papo”, Atty. Deloso was born on September 3, 1938, in Barangay San Isidro, Botolan, Zambales, to his loving parents, the late Martin Ramos Deloso and Natividad Arindaeng Dominado, being the third among their children;

Whereas, demonstrating brilliance and a strong commitment to justice and public service, he earned his Bachelor of Laws Degree from the prestigious University of the Philippines College of Law on April 3, 1960;



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Whereas, demonstrating brilliance and a strong commitment to justice and public service, he earned his Bachelor of Laws Degree from the prestigious University of the Philippines College of Law on April 3, 1960;

Whereas, his exceptional dedication to family and fatherhood earned him the Ulirang Ama Award from the Supreme Court of the Philippines, having successfully guided and raised six of his nine children to become lawyers themselves;

Whereas, Atty. Amor D. Deloso served with steadfast dedication, courage and vision as the Municipal Mayor of Botolan, Zambales from 1972 to 1986, during which he spearheaded critical infrastructure, including the National Irrigation Administration irrigation project that vitalized local agriculture and steered the municipality through transformative years and laying crucial foundations for its progress;

Whereas, expanding his dedication to public service, he went on to serve as the Governor of the Province of Zambales in 1986 following the People Power Revolution, elected as Governor in 1988 to 1998, returned to the Provincial Capitol as governor from 2007 to 2010 and again from 2016 to 2019, making him one of the province's longest-serving provincial leaders and leaving an indelible mark on the political, economic and social landscape of the entire province through his leadership and love for the Zambalenos;

Whereas, he stands in the annals of history as the only leader from the Municipality of Botolan to serve as the Governor of the Province of Zambales to date;

Whereas, his legacy remains visible in the unique public architecture across Zambales schools and public plazas featuring inverted "D" fences where "D" stands for Deloso and its inverted orientation symbolizes an umbrella providing shelter, security, and protection to all Zambalenos;

Whereas, throughout his long and distinguished career in law and governance, Atty. Deloso earned the respect, admiration, and deep affection of his constituents for his fighting spirit, passion for justice, and unwavering advocacy for the welfare of the public;

Whereas, the passing of Atty. Amor Dominado Deloso is a monumental loss not only to his family and loved ones, but also to the Municipality of Botolan and the Province of Zambales, which have lost a pillar of local governance and a respected statesman. He leaves a legacy that will inspire future generations of public servants;

Whereas, it is fitting and proper for the Sangguniang Bayan of Botolan, representing the entire municipality, to pay tribute to the only Botoleno who became the Governor of Zambales for a long time, as we join his family in their moment of deep sorrow;

Now therefore, with the unanimous accord of all the members of the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled, be it;



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Resolved, as it is hereby resolved to confer a Posthumous Award of Honor and Distinction upon the late **ATTY. AMOR DOMINADO DELOSO**, in recognition of his extraordinary leadership, exemplary life and devoted public service;

Resolved further, that a copy of this resolution be presented to the bereaved family of the late Atty. Amor Dominado Deloso as a token of deep sympathy, respect, and enduring gratitude, with prayers that the Lord Almighty grant his soul eternal rest.
